## HTC

- OVC-funded anti-trafficking victim service training and technical assistance (TTA) provider grantee
- Supports your OVC-funded anti-trafficking victim service program through customized TTA

- Identifying systematic barriers to address challenges.

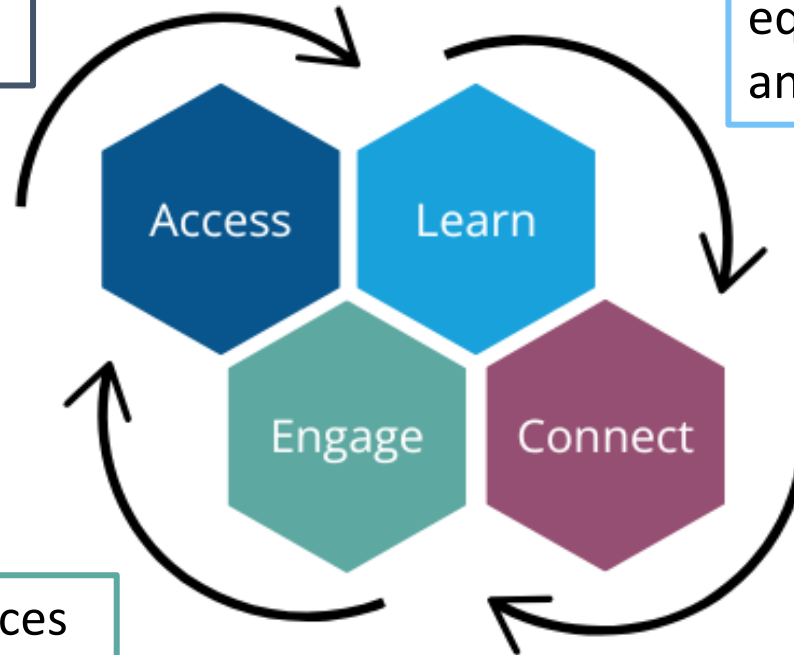
# Implementing HTC's Approach

**Engage** in the work using best practices to improve positive outcomes, and to avoid causing harm.

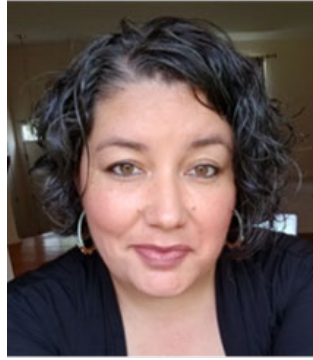
**Connect** to resources, peer organizations/agencies, and HTC TTA team support.

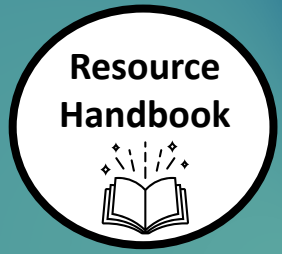

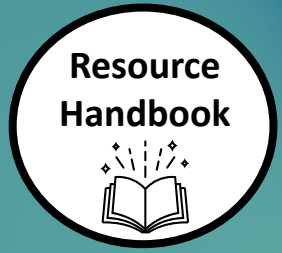

## TA Navigators

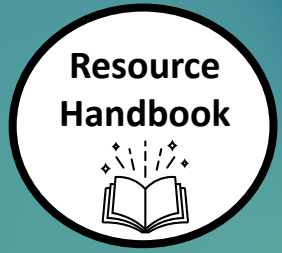
Bring their expertise to improve identification and service delivery. They:
