## MOU for the Provision of Sexual Assault Advocate Services to the Regional SANE Project (Adapted for this replication guide)

- 1. Parties: FRIS, Women's Aid in Crisis (WAIC), and HOPE, Inc.
- 2. Roles and Responsibilities: FRIS will provide for the training of advocates by hiring or contracting with a qualified sexual assault advocate instructor to conduct the initial advocate training as well as a training of trainers. FRIS will also provide all necessary training materials, secure adequate training space, and provide other technical assistance as may be necessary and reasonable.

**HOPE and WAIC** will, with grant assistance from FRIS, each employ an advocate coordinator who will—

- Establish a volunteer sexual assault advocate program.
- Work on a part-time basis to provide sexual assault advocacy services to the participating hospitals.
- Coordinate the recruitment of volunteer sexual assault advocates.
- Assist in the training of volunteer sexual assault advocates.
- Develop a system for ongoing support, scheduling, and training of these volunteer advocates.
- Provide supervision and guidance to volunteer advocates.
- Develop and implement an on-call/scheduling process for advocates.
- Meet with and debrief these advocates following crisis intervention, as needed.
- Assist with local/regional SANE/SART planning and training activities and other duties.

Contingent on receipt of required documentation, FRIS will pay HOPE and WAIC \$15,036 each per year for providing on-call sexual assault advocacy at the participating hospitals.
